ALL ASIA DX TEST

The All Asia DX Test on August 26 and 27 starts the NCCC's 1972-73 contest season. As it was last year, our objective again is to astound and amaze the world by winning EVERYTHING !

Rules for the test are as usual. It's a CW only affair monopolizing 160 through 10 Meters from 1000 GMT on the 26th until 1600 GMT on the 27th. The exchange is a five digit number consisting of RST and the operator's age (00 for yls). The same station may be worked once on each band. Final score is the total number of QSO's multiplied by the sum of different Asian prefixes worked on each band. Entry categories are single-op single band, single-op multi-band, and multi-op single transmitter. Multi-op multi-transmitter is NOT permitted.

As you statistical wizards have figured out by now, we've got to take top honors in all eight categories to achieve our Club objective. To help spur us on to such great heights (and to release all that pent-up aggression accumulated during the summer doldrums), we will spice things up again with a bit on intra-club competition. Tokyo Tom, W 6 Nippon Uzbek Thailand, has agreed to be war lord for our Red Team, while arch rival Japanese Jim, W 6 China Ulan* Formosa, will lead the Yellow Hoard. Team assignments for the remaining masses will be found inside the fortune cookies served at the July 7 NCCC Banquet (Note our cleverly subtle way of insuring attendance!).

Team scoring this year will take a slightly different "slant" from our past practice in hopes of correcting last year's inequities. The highest scoring club entry in each category will receive 100 points (or 100%). Other entrants in that same category receive points corresponding to the percentage their scores are of the winning score (eg. if the second place 40 meter entry is 85% of the winner's score, second place receives 85 points.). In addition to the above, a bonus of 50 points will be awarded to the club winner in each category.

The team with the largest point total wins the club competition and some suitable prize yet to be determined. To be counted, each member's log must be received by his team captain not later than September 15. We will forward all club entries to the JARL.
