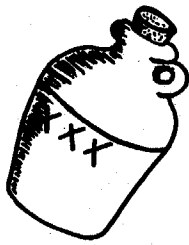

Comparable or maybe slightly better conditions than last year prevailed, and you Butt-Kickers came on strong despite numerous equipment failures at key stations. To achieve our hoped-for 12 million points, 8.5 Meg. is needed from the phone SS weekend. This sounds like a big #, but higher scores for the same effort are possible on SSB due to higher rates and increased activity. A tri-bander station can produce 700-1000 QSO's; a big gun, above 1000 QSO's. All it takes is endurance and commitment to put in the time to let the log fill up, and throat lozenges! So please make arrangements to reduce football watching, social and family activities on Nov. 20-21 to a level where a maximum SS effort on phone is possible. I hope that you all share the thought that a second gavel for the club is worth this effort. Don't forget, though, that the most important effort of all is to send in your logs, summary sheets and check sheets to ARRL indicating your participation with NCCC. Also, be sure to let your Coordinator know your score ASAP.

Our November meeting will be concerned with rehashing the SS weekends, telling war stories, excuses, and contest high-lights. Put Saturday, December 18 on your social calendar, and call WB6DSV for reservations for our annual Xmas party and Awards Banquet. It's the biggie event of the NCCC year!

ARRL SS CW. A triumph and a disappointment. Murphy rampaged wildly and indiscriminantly, afflicting big guns, little guns, and medium guns alike. Some of these afflicted hung in there gamely; others didn't. Some relative contest neophytes set the bands on fire; some old pros didn't even make it on the bands, or else put in only token efforts. A decidedly mixed bag, this ARRL SS CW.

And where, in this kaleidoscope of rapid rates and missing multipliers, of blown linears and playing slopers, do NCCC's chances for a NATIONAL TITLE stand? Well, it definitely won't be the 15 Meg. walkover we confidently predicted at the Hayward October meeting. PVRC will not be blown right off the map into the Atlantic depths. Instead, NCCC must come through in the clutch on PHONE--or forever be known as that West Coast club that got lucky one year when PVRC let down through boredom with #1-itis.

Our true CW score(PAA was sandbagging on p. 1) is just a fraction under 5 Meg., gang. This is probably a new SS record. We made 4.3 Meg. on CW and 5.8 Meg. on phone last year(We lost 1/2 Meg. on disqualifications and failures to submit entries). That phone score was based on 7 fewer entries than the CW one. It seems pretty obvious that 12 Meg(should WIN it!) is within our reach--IF IF IF EVERYBODY shows his true mettle as a contender of repute for one lousy 24-hour period next weekend.

Some Outstanding Achievements in SS CW

Congratulatory remarks are undeniably warranted in the case of a station/operator making his predicted score (within 5%--slide-rule error). This was indeed accomplished by WA6NGG, W6OKK, K6PJY, and K6PU (WB6CEP opr.). Classified as "Sandbagger" (alternate definition: "Most Improved") are the following stn/ops, who exceeded their predictions by more than 5%: K6DC (K6STI), WA6DIL, WA6DQM, WA6JUD (M/O), W6KQG, K6MA (+VE3DXV), WA7NIN (W6OAT), WB6OQT, W6PAA, K6SSJ (WA6DGX), K6VVA, and W6ZT. Last, but certainly not least, accolade-worthy are the stn/ops who broke through that magic 100K barrier: WB6AIN, K6AUC (+K6ILM), K6DC, WA6DIL, WA6DQM, W6JZU (WA6TLV), W6KQG, W6MSF (WB6LPK + WA6ENP), W6MUR (K6ZX), WA6NGG, WA7NIN (W6OAT), W6OKK, W6PAA, K6PU (WB6CEP), K6QZ/6, WA6UZA/6 (+K6EBB), K6VVA, W6YX (M/O).

No Logs, No #1

While this topic has already been mentioned before, it is so important that we repeat it again. Mail in your logs! Either hand 'em over to your local AC (Area Coordinator) or send 'em to ARRL yourself, but DO IT! We lost quite a few points because a number of people, mostly smaller entries, failed to do this last year. Since it may be close, please don't fail us in 1976.

If you elect to mail the logs yourself, a handy hint is to enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard containing the words "SS logs for (your callsign) have been received at ARRL." The deadline is right after Christmas, but mail early so you have some recourse if the Post Office fouls up.

Before mailing the logs, carefully check for dupes (we lost several hundred thousand points last year on this one!) and make a xerox copy of both summary sheets to give to your AC. We need this copy to assure accurate Club records.

Some SS CW Soapbox

As this JUG is being put out in a super rush so you will have the scores before the Phone Weekend, only a limited number of stories have come to the attention of your scribe thus far. While we had a record number of entries (75), a bundle of Clean Sweeps (W6PAA, WA7NIN/OAT, W6JZU/TLV, W6YX/multi, W6BIP/+DJI, & W6UA), some significant improvements over last year (W6PAA, WA7NIN/OAT, K6PU/CEP, W6JZU/TLV, WB6AIN, WA6DIL, W6YX/multi, W6KQG, W6OKK, WA6MQS/VEF, W6BIP/+DJI, WA6BMV, K6AYA/+OEC, K6BR, K6ZM, K6QX, WA6JUD, W6KZJ, K6TG, and possibly others not yet accounted for), and a new SS CW Club record score, it could have been so much better had not Murphy struck repeatedly! It is impossible to go into details here due to lack of space (come to the November meeting to hear all about it), but let us just listen to this small sample: 1)keyer problems shut down WA7NIN and W6KHI for several hours apiece, and finally drove WALKID/6 off the air when Bob became frustrated in his efforts to find a replacement; 2)at K6HIH and WB6DSV, it was the suds-machine that went west, finally forcing Cliff to go barefoot and George to drive up to Belmont to borrow a spare amp from WA6DQM; 3)W6NUT's 40 m yagi began to arc over, causing incredible local interference and inducing Tom to flick it in;

(from p.5)... 4) W1ARR/6 threw his back out while wildly grabbing for a rolling pencil about 0230, and alternated between operation and rest periods for 12 hours before the pain got to be too much and he headed for home; 5) WAØENP/WA6SFT came down with a bug Saturday a.m. which had him on his back most of the contest, causing LPK to switch to MSF and leaving LPK's station (97K last year) high & dry. Because of the above equipment/operator problems, you are reminded to PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE NOTIFY YOUR AREA COORDINATOR AND/OR VPCC WB6DSV (739-4233) OF ANY LAST MINUTE CHANGES OR EQUIPMENT FAILURES! THEY MAY BE ABLE TO HELP. Bear in mind that Murphy's beat PVRC for the first time in post-WW II history in 1973, only to lose to PVRC the next year by a measly 80K!! Your phone call could stop history from repeating itself and clinch for us SS#1 #2.

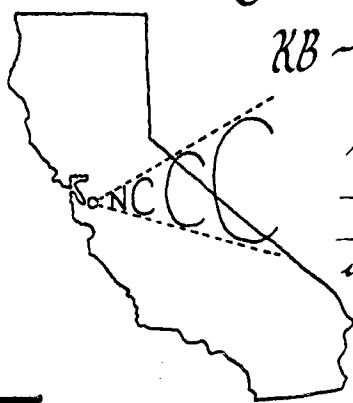
