

THESE TOWERS SUPPORT 16 DIFFERENT BIG YAGI ANTENNAS WITH A TOTAL OF 101 ELEMENTS! ALSO SHOWN WERE VIEWS OF W3WJD, K6OYE, K6SEN(NOW KØRF), K6RU, K6UA/W6VSS, K6ZM, N6DX, N6RO, WA7NIN, W7RM. ALSO SHOWN WERE COLOR MOVIES OF THE ERECTION OF A 5 EL 40 M YAGI WITH A 100' BOOM ON A 120' ROTATING MAST, AND THE INSTALLATION OF A 96' XMAS TREE SYSTEM ON THE BEACH AT KH6 LAND.




