

1994 California QSO Party Results

Brought to you in record time, here are the results of the 1994 California QSO Party. Despite the dismal solar flux of late, this great contest, which across the country and even beyond is used to mark the start of the fall contest season, has continued to grow in popularity. And CQP94 was definitely one for the record books. We had a record level of participation in the contest. Out-of-state log submissions were up 31% over last year and the total number received showed greater year-to-year growth than we have seen since 1986. The chart below illustrates the last 20 years of CQP participation in order to back up our claim of biggest and best CQP ever.



All 58 states and provinces were out in force this year in order to give the CA ops an exciting chase. A whopping 40 of the 6-landers managed to find them all to get a clean sweep into their logs. And thanks to N6TV's armtwisting to get mobilers and expeditioners out on the road, all 58 California counties were there for the Auslanders to find. In the process of all this, 5 new California county records were set and 11 old state/province records fell by the wayside. Super work by all.

Top honors this year went to southerner Ken, AB6FO. With 825 CW QSO's in his log (the greatest number of any entry), Ken managed to nose out Andy, AE6Y, who actually had more total QSO's but not enough of the right kind. Congratulations, Ken. Only a slim margin kept third place WA6AUE out ahead of N6EK. And once again, despite serious competition, the top CA multi-single entry came from the guys operating W6EEN in Riverside County. Meanwhile, back up north, old master N6RO was joined by K3EST to take top multi-multi honors. Outside the Golden State, VE7NTT bested second-place W7QQ in the process of breaking his own record for British Columbia. Third place came from low-power entry AA8AV all the way from Michigan. K8AQW again put together a top team of Wolverines to turn in a M/M entry with the second greatest out-of-state point total. And finally, a very special thanks from us Sixes to N8LXS, who put on an out-of-state expedition to normally-rare Idaho to win his place in the NCCC record books.

Herewith, in this special CQP edition of the JUG, are all the details for you to pour over. Kudos aplenty are in order to K6PU for bringing us the results in absolutely record time. Ken gave up (*Pres. con't page 2, col 1*)

CQP results have pre-empt my usual space, so your scores will appear in next month's JUG.

New Rules. During the past nine or ten months, myself and others have received suggestions regarding rule changes to our California QSO Party, known as CQP. We had no time to do anything before CQP '94, since the magazines require submitting the contest rules almost immediately after the present Board of Directors began serving our sentence...er, term. Then came the big SS push, and now we're in February. If we will monkey with the rules, now is the time to begin.

But before we get carried away, let me remind you that CQP is the premiere state QSO party. The present BOD is unanimous in its reluctance to "mess with success". We wish to inform you of the suggestions put forth and invite your comments. Please give this matter some deep thought and tell me what you decide. This request is printed in this issue, along with the CQP '94 results, and is sent to all CQP participants—not just NCCC members. We are interested in receiving the opinions of non-Californians as well.

Basic philosophy and a ground rule Successful contests have lots of activity. Things that promote activity are desirable. Our ground rule is that any changes cannot create a significant increase in workload to our CQP log maestro or our awards chairman. (A large increase in log submissions is acceptable, though!)

Suggestions received:

1. Restrict the California club entry category to "medium" sized local or regional clubs. "Medium" to be defined later.
2. Add a QRP category (< 5W output power)
3. Change CW QSO points to double those for phone
4. Restart all scoring records

Each suggestion would increase activity and competitiveness, according to sponsors. Each has problems as well, ranging from minor to extreme, according to detractors.

What do YOU think? Remember our goals. Is CQP "broken"? Does any idea have enough merit for adoption on an experimental basis (1995 only)? Let me know! Feed back via the usual methods:
